

With the generous support of one of our patients, BIDMC Urology has created the BUFFER Fund (BIDMC Urology Funds for Education and Research). BUFFER offers a portfolio of dedicated funds for our urology faculty to initiate pilot projects within the Division.

Dr. Boris Gershman, an expert urologic oncologist, is the inaugural recipient of this new funding source. He will use his award to develop a “Longitudinal Non-Muscle Invasive Bladder Cancer Biorepository.”
